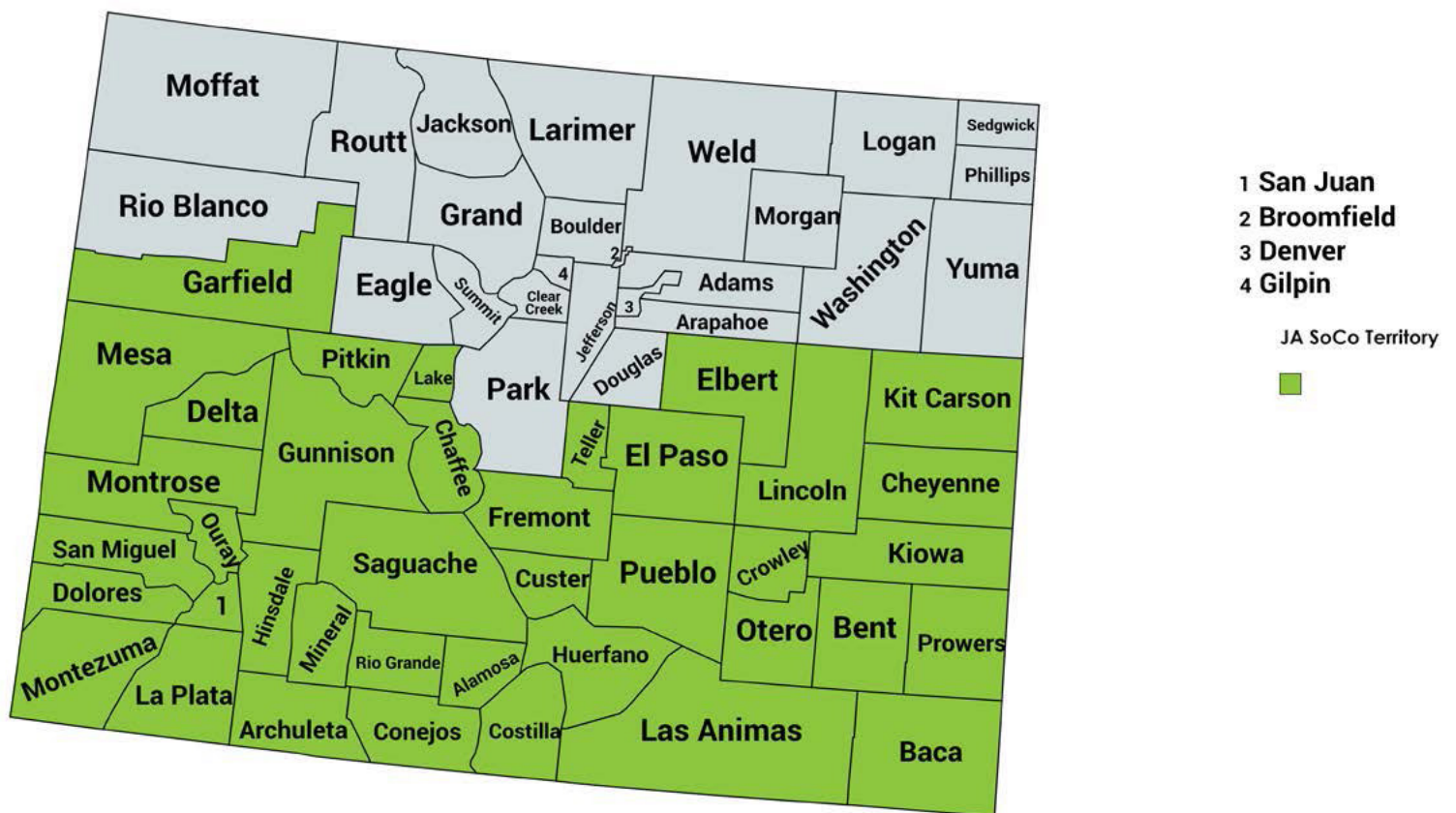

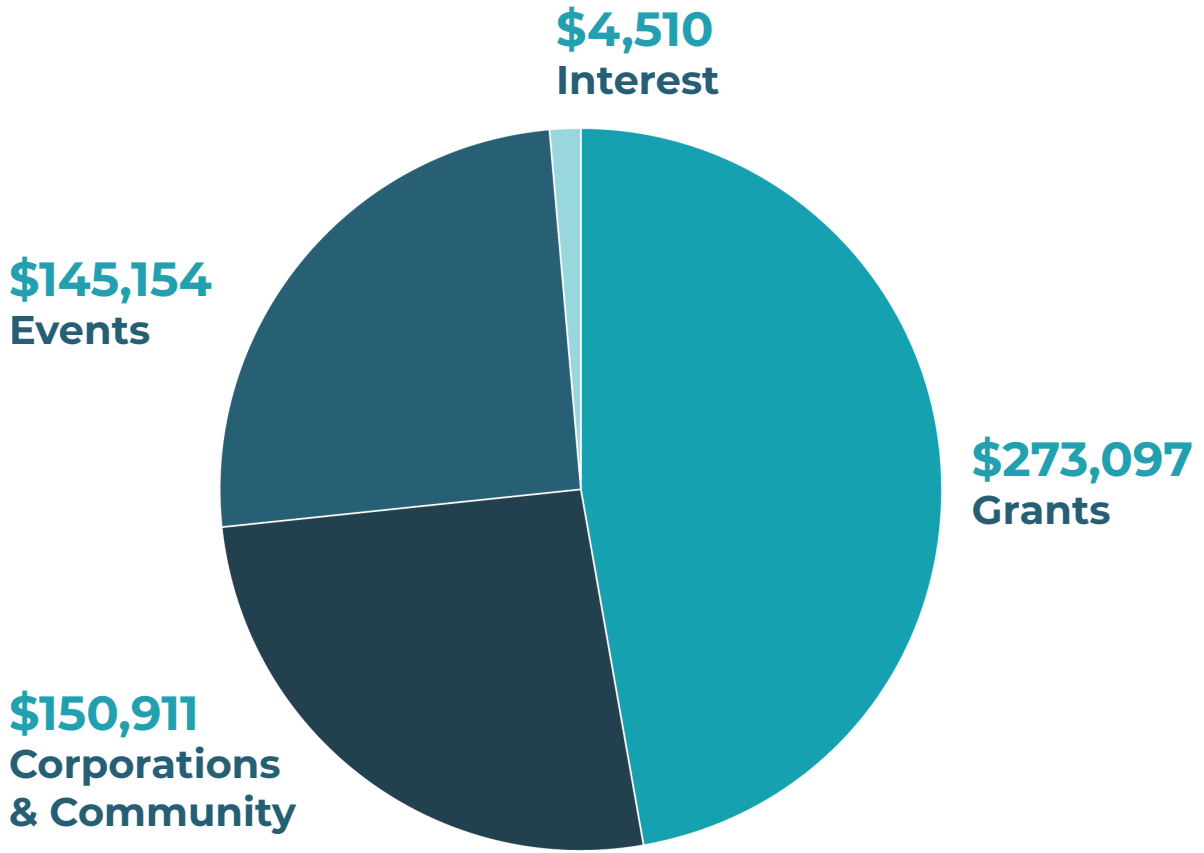
MAP OF OPERATING COUNTIES

The map below defines the operating counties of Junior Achievement of Southern Colorado:



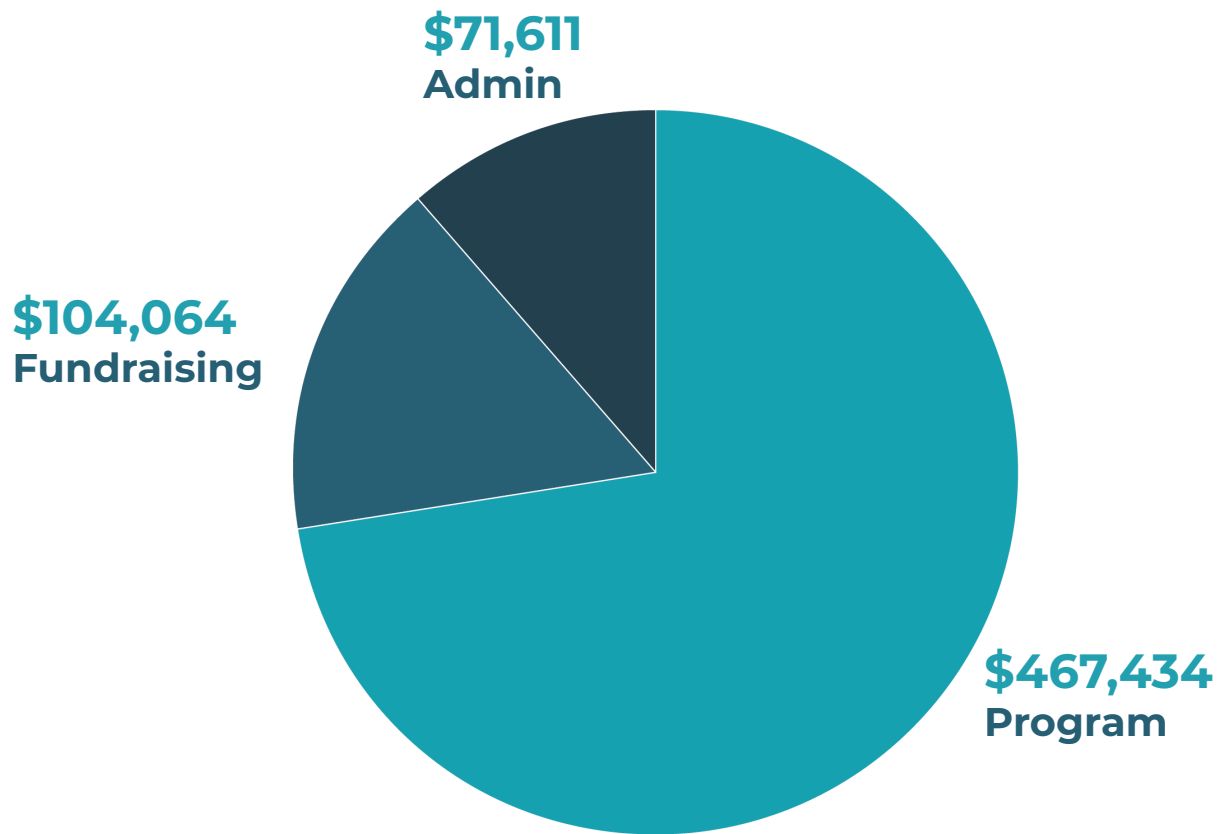

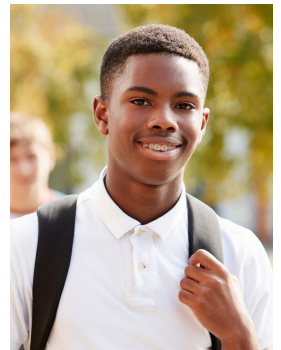
